# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the General Federation of Women's Club is at the forefront of grassroots community service, providing crucial support to cultural, educational, health, and legislative issues of importance to women, children, and families throughout our community; and

**WHEREAS**, GFWC Clearwater Community Women's Club, GFWC North Pinellas Woman's Club, and the GFWC Woman's Club of Clearwater are members of the General Federation of Women's Clubs, and its members have enhanced the citizens and community of Clearwater and Pinellas County through their commitment to volunteer service for 106 years; and

**WHEREAS**, the 246+ members of these three General Federation Women's Clubs in Clearwater volunteered over 40,000 hours and donated over \$229,000 in local community grants, scholarships, cash and in-kind donations in 2019 alone; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Federation of Women's Club is celebrating 100 years since the passage of the 19<sup>th</sup> amendment on August 26, 1920, that gave women the right to vote;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRANK V. HIBBARD**, Mayor of the City of Clearwater, Florida, on behalf of the Clearwater City Council, do hereby proclaim August 26, 2020 to be
